EU Programmes Seminar **Lisbon, 6-10 November 2006**

Final Declaration

We, the participants in the EU Programmes seminar held in Lisbon on 6-10 November 2006 in the framework of the EuroMed Training of Public Administrations Programme of the European Commission, managed by the EuropeAid Cooperation Office, supported by the MEDA Programme in the context of the Euro-Mediterranean Policy, make the following declaration:
